CAPE@Thingwall Primary School:

As you will already be aware, the ex-Stanley School land and remaining building was allocated to Thingwall by the Local Authority when Stanley School relocated to their new building.

We are delighted to inform you that, as a result of a very detailed tendering process, CAPE (our existing Before and After School Club provider) have been awarded sole use of the building following a unanimous vote by our school leadership team, our non-parent governors and the Local Authority. This is an exciting time for the school and for CAPE and we are sure you will be eager to know how the school will benefit from this arrangement. The CAPE@Thingwall Primary School offer will therefore consist of...

 A brand new, state of the art pre-school facility for children aged 2 ½ years to school age.
 Morning session - 9am to 12 noon
 Option to stay for lunch - 12 noon to 12.35pm

Afternoon session - 12.35pm to 3.35pm

✓ Full wrap-around care (Before and After School Club) for children aged 2 ½ to 12 years. Children will be taken into school and collected by CAPE as per the usual arrangements. Please note that the upper age range has been extended to include past pupils who have moved to Year 7 as we recognise that certain children may prefer to use this facility rather than let themselves in at home - an overwhelming process for some.

Morning session - 7.30am to 8.55am Afternoon session - 3.30pm to 6.30pm

- ✓ <u>Holiday Club Facility for 2 ½ to 12 years.</u> This will be run between the existing facility which is provided by CAPE at Irby Primary and at our new venue.
- ✓ Lunchtime Care Facility for our new FS2 September starters from 12 noon to 1.10pm. This will suit our new parents who find it too difficult to sort lunchtime childcare due to work commitments. This is an optional extra for new parents and a small cost will be applied should they wish to take advantage of this facility for some/all of the staggered start lunchtime period. This facility will run from 05.09.16 to 19.09.16 when new children will be allowed to stay for the lunchtime period.

We are sure this new facility will prove to be very popular and the CAPE@Thingwall Primary School team will hold a launch event later on this term to showcase their new facilities - parents will obviously be invited to this exciting launch so keep an eye out for future newsletters.
