For those of you who haven't experienced a performance at Thingwall before, we operate a ticketed system to ensure everyone has a fair chance to see their child/children. We will release two tickets per family in the first instance and place you on a reservation list for additional tickets. We will then release the additional tickets the day before. We rarely disappoint people and everyone usually gets the amount of tickets they request. We do not charge for the tickets but we do collect for out two chosen charities if you would like to donate a pound or two. The system usually works well and tickets are available from the school office from 27.11.17 for KS2 and from 04.12.17 for KS1 and FS2. If you have children in different key stages you are allocated two tickets per key stage performance in the first instance.

Sponsored Event

We raised a grand total of £1600 for our 'Walk a Mile' event meaning an overall total of £2300 when you factor in the profit from the Family Fun Day. This means we are able to spend £1000 on Early Years (FS2) and £1300 on whole school maths. Many thanks for your support and generosity, we really do appreciate it. George (FS2) raised the most sponsor money (a whopping £180!) so he received his £20 book token prize during Friday's assembly last week. As you can imagine he was completely thrilled!
